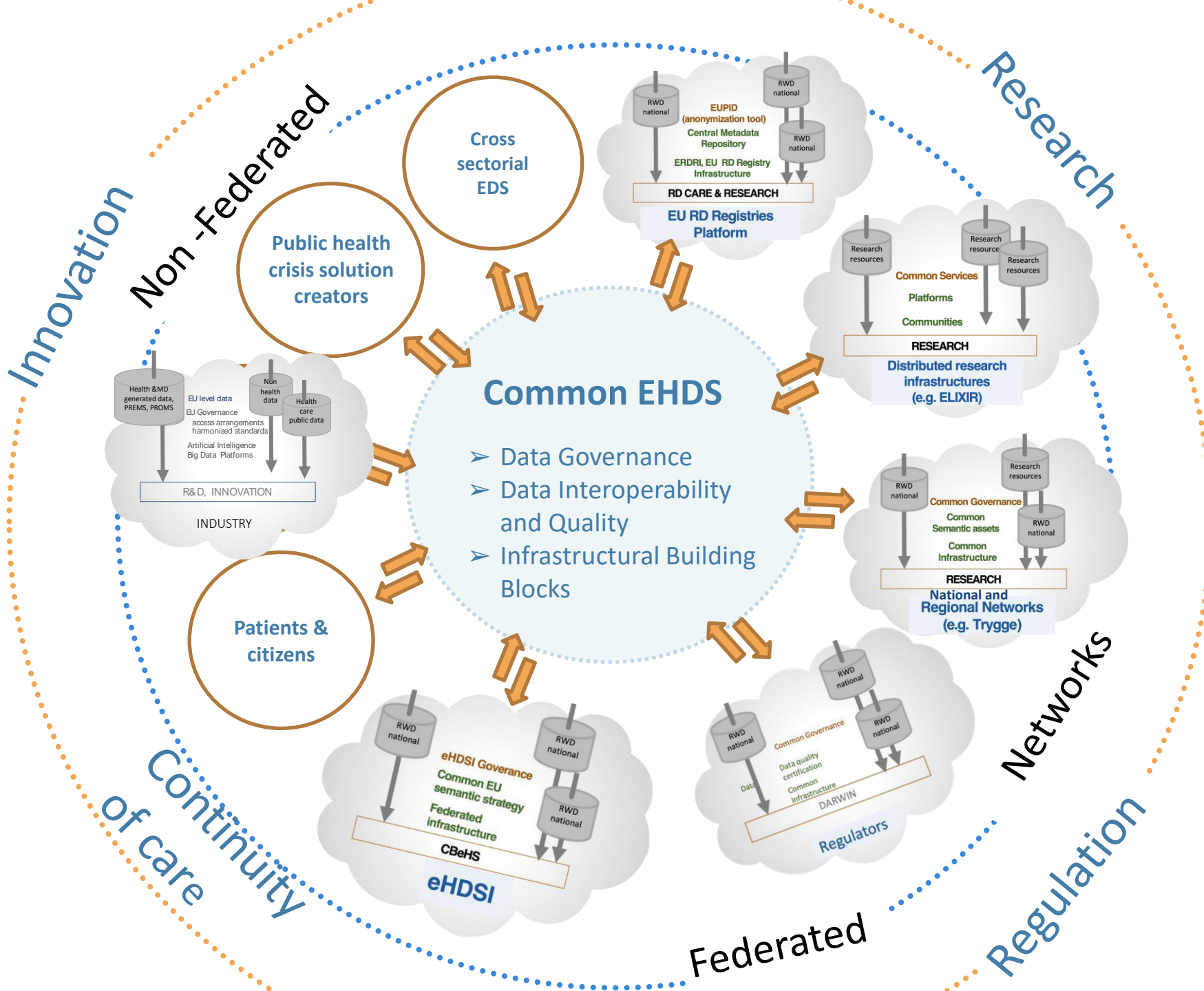

- >5 workshop sessions

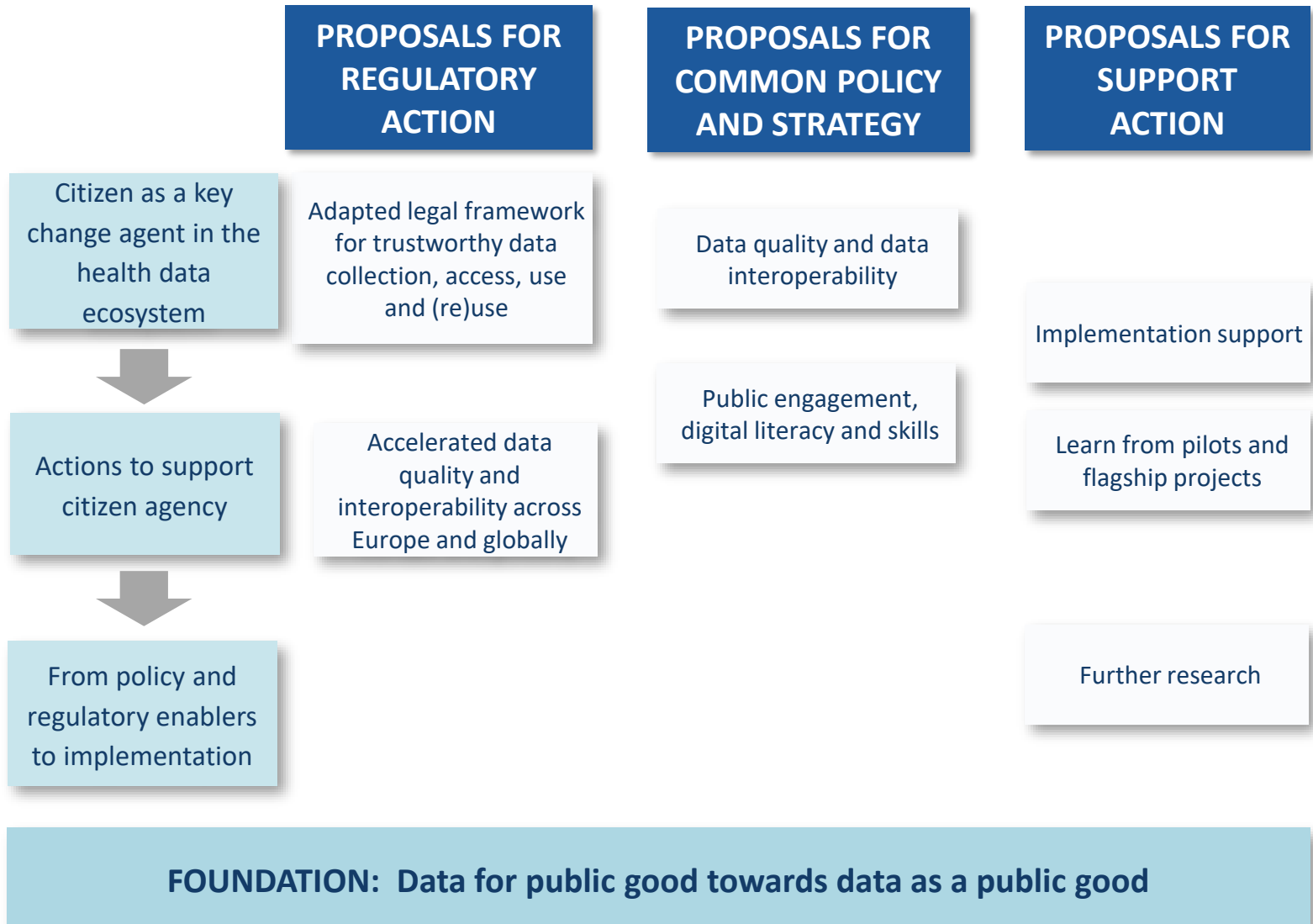
